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## Want to help but don't know where to start?

## Here's a list of things you can do to support breastfeeding + bond with your Baby + make Mom happy!

- Help mom to position baby at the breast and check for signs of a correct latch
  - Lips flanged
  - Chin pressed into breast

- No dimpling of cheeks or clicking sounds
- Swallowing sounds <aah, aah, cah,cah...>
- Rhythmic jaw movement seen back to the ear

HEY DADS!

- Change baby's diapers and keep a record of how many wet/dirty diapers There should be at least 5-6 wet disposable diapers, or 6-8 wet cloth diapers and 3-4 "Loonie-size" bowel movements per day (after day 3-4)
- Burp baby put a towel over your shoulder and pat baby's back like you're dribbling a basketball
- Change out of work clothes as soon as you get home so that you smell like "Dad" and not "The Office"
- Limit visitors during the first week (unless they bring a casserole!) so that mom and baby can rest
- Do "Infant Massage" ~ check out the book "Infant Massage: A handbook for loving parents" by V. Schneider It even has a special chapter JUST FOR DADS!!
- Help prepare meals (it doesn't have to be a gourmet extravaganza)
- Housework (any/all).....never complain about a dirty house
- Laundry -if you're not sure, use cold water only so that colors won't run
- Massage mom's neck, shoulders, feet etc. frequently!
- Fend off the world so mom can get some extra sleep when the baby sleeps during the day ... take the phone off the hook, put a sign on the door ... She will love you for this, guaranteed!
- When mom is breastfeeding, bring her a nice, cold drink and snack ...and maybe the remote control, TV guide, favorite book, telephone, post-natal vitamins, etc. Make up your own routine!
- Play 'n' Cuddle with baby ~ you can't do it too much or do it wrong!
- Read to baby and mom after you lovingly brush mom's hair
- Bathe baby and/or take a bath with baby, they'll LOVE it!
- Encourage and compliment mom for breastfeeding (often and always!)
- Reinforce that her job as a mom counts as much or more than a job that brings home a paycheque
- Always be mom's biggest advocate and supporter!
- Never ask mom to leave the room for breastfeeding
- Breastfeeding is a basic human right, therefore.....
- Encourage mom to breastfeed anytime, anywhere!
